#### NOVENA OF PRAYER

Archbishop Farrell has invited us all to participate in a nine-day period of prayer for the renewal of the Church in the Archdiocese of Dublin which begins today on the Feast of the Ascension. As Dr Farrell said at the Holy Thursday Chrism Mass in the Pro-Cathedral:

"In our diocese, the Building Hope initiative involves people and priests creating a joint mission – a mission together – in which new pastoral areas will comprise a number of parishes in partnership. This necessarily involves a 'letting go' of the past and an embrace of what is to come. For this pastoral initiative to be successful, there needs to be a shared appreciation of the rationale, and a shared conviction of the necessity to embrace change... Rather than viewing change as a negative, the real challenge is to see change as an opportunity for creative ways to sustain a viable and vibrant future for the faith communities of our Diocese... Let us not be under any illusion as to the demand and depth of that change. In fact, it might be more accurate to call it a conversion." Here's the prayer we are all invited to say from today May 21st [The Ascension of the Lord] to May 29th [Feast of Our Lady, Mother of the Church]:

#### NOVENA PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

for the renewal of the Church in the Archdiocese of Dublin

Come, Holy Spirit, revive and renew us.

Come, Holy Spirit, inspire and enthuse us.

Come, Holy Spirit, unbind and release us.

Open our eyes to see God's grace around us.

Open our ears to hear God's voice within us. Open our hearts to welcome God among us.

Send us out with joy to live the Gospel. Send us out with peace to act as one. Send us out with love to build up hope.

Pin it up on your fridge or slip it into your prayer book. Let every household take home a prayer card with this text which is available at the back of the church and pray it together.

#### POPE FRANCIS ON WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY

"As Christians, we know that the destiny of peace is decided by conversion of hearts, since the virus of war comes from within the human heart. From the heart come the right words to dispel the shadows of a closed and divided world and to build a civilization which is better than the one we have received. Each of us is asked to engage in this effort, but it is one that especially appeals to the sense of responsibility of those working in the field of communications so that they may carry out their profession as a mission. May the Lord Jesus, the pure Word poured out from the heart of the Father, help us to make our communication clear, open and heartfelt. May the Lord Jesus, the Word made flesh, help us listen to the beating of hearts, to rediscover ourselves as brothers and sisters, and to disarm the hostility that divides. May the Lord Jesus, the Word of truth and love, help us speak the truth in charity, so that we may feel like protectors of one another."

Let's keep them and those others currently preparing for their First Communion and Confirmation in the communion of prayer.
