SILENCE: "Silence is essential in the life of the believer. Indeed, it lies at the beginning and end of Christ's earthly existence. The Word, the Word of the Father, became 'silence' in the manger and on the cross, on the night of the Nativity and on the night of his Passion... brothers and sisters, in common prayer we ask to learn again to be silent: to listen to the voice of the Father, the call of Jesus and the groaning of the Spirit. Let us ask that the Synod be a kairós [God's now] of fraternity, a place where the Holy Spirit will purify the Church from gossip, ideologies and polarization. As we approach the important anniversary of the great Council of Nicaea, let us ask that we may know how, like the Magi, to worship in unity and in silence the mystery of God made man, certain that the closer we are to Christ, the more united we will be among ourselves." LOVE IS A VERB: St Paul wrote: "There is a variety of gifts but always the same Spirit; there are all sorts of service to be done, but always to the same Lord; working in all sorts of different ways in different people, it is the same God who is working in all of them" [1 Corinthians 12: 4-6]. Paul goes on to describe how all these acts of service and sharing of our gifts builds up the body of

Christ, all energized by faith, hope and - the greatest of these - love.

"Always be thankful," he goes on to say in Colossians 3:15. So it is very appropriate for myself and Fr Denis to take the opportunity this weekend to thank the myriad of our parishioners who give so generously of themselves and their gifts voluntarily in the building up of the many vital aspects of our community life. The local Body of Christ that gathers here in Our Lady Mother of the Church would be so much the poorer without this giving of yourselves. We are so grateful to you and for you, our parish volunteers. We are truly indebted to you. We see in the life of Christ that love is a verb, a dynamism that comes to serve others. May Our Lady, whose response to this

ADSUMUS SANCTE SPIRITUS: The authorship of this prayer is attributed to St Isidore of Seville who lived circa 560 to 636. The first words of the Latin original, Adsumus Sancte Spiritus, mean: "We stand before You, Holy Spirit." It has been historically used at Synods and major Church gatherings for many hundreds of years. Every session of the Second Vatican Council began with this prayer. It invites the Holy Spirit to live, breathe and work within us so that we may be a community and a people of grace. Please pray it for the entire month of October in communion with those participating in the Synod in Rome. The text is available on a little card which you can take home with you.

OPEN HEARTS TAIZÉ PRAYER: Come and join this meditative, chanted prayer led by our young people this coming Friday 13th October at 7pm. All are welcome. A busload of our young people took part in the very beautiful "Together 2023" Ecumenical Taizé Prayer in Christchurch Cathedral on Saturday 30th September last at which our Family Mass Group were in fine voice as part of a massed choir of forty people. This moment of prayer was one of over 220 worldwide mirroring the Taizé prayer taking place at that very time in St Peter's Square, Rome, entrusting the work of the Synod to the Holy Spirit.
