THE LOGIC OF DRAWING NEAR: "At the end of the world, the Lord will inspect the flock, and he will do so not only from the perspective of the shepherd, but also from the perspective of the sheep, with whom he has identified. And he will ask us: "Were you a little bit like a shepherd as myself?" "Were you a shepherd to me who was present in those people who were in need, or were you indifferent?" Brothers and sisters, let us look at the logic of indifference... looking away when we see a problem. Let us remember the parable of the Good Samaritan. That poor man, wounded by the brigands, thrown to the ground, between life and death, was there alone. A priest passed by, saw, and went on his way. He looked the other way. A Levite passed by, saw and looked the other way. Before my brothers and sisters in need, am I indifferent like this priest, like this Levite and look the other way? I will be judged on this: on how I drew near, how I looked on Jesus present in those in need. This is the logic, and it is not I who is saying this: Jesus says it. "What you did to that person and that person and that person, you did it to me. And what you did not do to that person and that person... you did not do it to me, because I was there". May Jesus teach us this logic of

being close, of drawing near to him, with love, in the person who is suffering most. -- Pope Francis
