Fay's 4th class in St Brigid's NS, wonderful sunflowers are gloriously adding colour to our church grounds and increasing the supply of pollen and nectar for the bees, butterflies and multiple insects. Apart from the sunflowers, all our plants are perennials - they will die back this winter and reappear next spring. We request your support in maintaining the biodiversity area. We need more volunteers to help with plant maintenance – watering, weeding, staking existing plants, being watchful that the fenced off area isn't disturbed.
