The Baptism of the Lord 12th January 2020

Today we bring the Christmas season to a close with the celebration of the Baptism of Jesus. This was a significant event in the life of Jesus. It marks the end of the 'hidden years' as Jesus grew up and lived in Nazareth and the begining of his public ministry of preaching and teaching the message of love and salvation to the people of Israel.

As Jesus is baptised in the river Jordan by John the Baptist, the Spirit of God is seen coming down on him. He is announced as the Son of God and is now ready to begin his great mission of proclaiming the Good News of salvation
